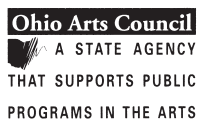

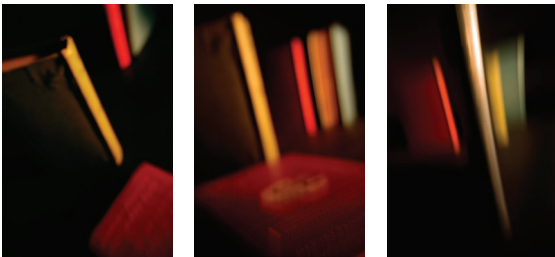

Kids & adults can create "mini-steamroller" prints in a free, family fun activity.



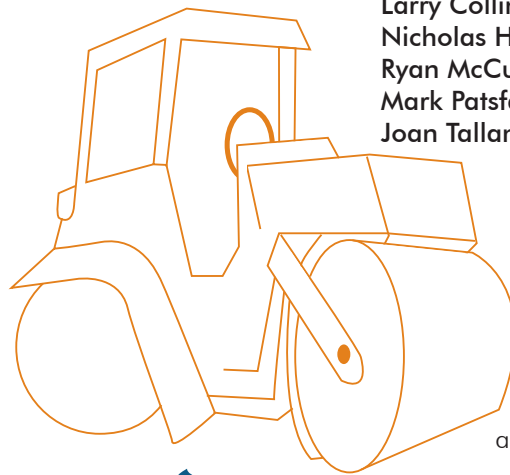
